Introduction

During the 1940s the beaches on the South Coast of England were very exposed to invasion. They were flat and wide which was the perfect landing ground for an invasion fleet. One town in particular was very exposed and so machine gun emplacements were put at either end of the very long beach with two machine guns in each one and six to ten soldiers. These were meant to defeat any invasion by strong professional and well equipped soldiers. It was of course totally inadequate. The orders to the soldiers in the emplacements were clear.

No one is to surrender. Everyone will fight to the last bullet.

The reasons for such a non negotiable order was simple. There was no one else who could resist. These few men and their two guns stood between the invasion and the town where their wives and children lived. Every night the emplacements were filled. Men were prepared to live by this order and if necessary die by it. They were 20th century example of this scripture, “Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.”

Korean intercessors stand in a similar position. It's a profound and dangerous position for intercessors to occupy.

Chapter 1. How the towers ministry started

Still Waters to la Verna and beyond

The towers ministry really began 20 years ago. My house is on the top of a hill looking over the South Downs (in the U.K) towards the sea. Early one morning I saw a light high up on the Downs and although I tried to convince myself it was reflection from a windscreen of a car. I knew it was not. One of my closest friends, who was very experienced in intercession said that she thought I had seen the light of the Holy Spirit and that we should pray. Out of that prayer time came the vision of Still Waters - a small intercessory group which would meet to pray.

We managed to find four others to join us and one morning we sat in a room with 6 chairs with no idea what to do. Week by week we met and slowly we began to understand how to intercede. Over 2 years we learned a great deal - almost all by experience.

That group eventually closed and I began to read and study the great intercessors of the last thousand years. I thought I had completed what I had to do, then one day the Lord said to me - "I want you to go to Geneva." So, I went but I couldn't understand why. Standing one day outside the headquarters of the International Red Cross buildings, which are based in Geneva, the Lord said to me, "They started small and your intercession experience is small. But like them you will grow. Follow the thread I will show you throughout Europe."

Over the next years I visited many holy places in Europe and at each place my intercessory experience did grow. Finally, after many years I came to La Verna. This is the mountain about two hours from Florence where Saint Francis received the stigmata. There was a monastery there and in it was the “Chapel of the stigmata”. I knelt there for an hour in prayer. “Now,” said the Lord, “I have told you what you need to know about intercession. Wait for my command.”

The years passed and I had almost forgotten this experience when in response to the situation in Gaza I started a four-night prayer series on the internet and from that the towers ministry began to grow.

Prayer cell

When the war between Israel and Gaza broke out in 2023/4, I was working on my mission base in Ghana. I held a four-session prayer time over a month for this war. About 10 people joined me online and 35 on catchup. As the prayer times began, I became aware that something unusual was happening during them and especially at the last one. During that prayer time the Lord told us that he was going to stand in the middle of the conflict area and asked which of us would stand with him. “We need a tower of intercession,” I said. “Who will occupy it with the Lord?” As so often in intercession I did not know what I was really asking for. Some of the group said they would stand in the tower. I thought that was the end of it. I was soon to discover it was far from the end of it.

During the subsequent weeks the Lord began to show me that a tower of intercession was a very strong spiritual presence, and that the tower in the Middle East would last until he returned. I asked him if there were any other such towers, and quickly he showed me many. Each one had a specific name reflecting its function. I know where some of them are but not all. I know that at this time I haven't identified all of them.

Early one morning

I woke up in the early hours of one morning and the atmosphere in my room was one I had never experienced before. There was utter stillness – a stillness which I could almost feel. I sat there wondering what was happening. Then the Lord spoke to me and said, “I’m going to show you a worldwide network of intercession. You must act!” While I was thinking about this during the next few days, the towers of intercession began to show themselves - Singapore and Hawaii being some of the first ones. This was a new experience for me. I could not understand how someone with no influence, no power and little financial resource could in any way influence a worldwide ministry. I didn’t choose this path. The Lord opened it for me.

Chapter 2. The forces against this tower

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
(Ephesians 6:10-11)

How might the enemy behave against this tower and its intercessors? He is going to be aggressive. He is always aggressive against intercessors that stand in his way. So it is useful to pray and study deeply into his purposes. I have come to understand these over many years of intercession and it helps me to know something of what I am facing. Field Marshall Montgomery said, "Know your enemy," and that is very true for serious intercessors. Here is what I have learnt.

*** Goliath – using power to dominate and kill**

On hearing the Philistine's words, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified.
(1 Samuel 17:11)

The enemy puts relentless pressure on intercessors. He wants to dominate in order to bring fear, despair and surrender. Over the years this can become very wearing and some intercessors have failed under this Goliath pressure.

* Diana of the Ephesians. The great deception

“About that time there arose a great disturbance about the Way. A silversmith named Demetrius, who made silver shrines of Artemis, brought in a lot of business for the craftsmen there. He called them together, along with the workers in related trades, and said: “You know, my friends, that we receive a good income from this business. And you see and hear how this fellow Paul has convinced and led astray large numbers of people here in Ephesus and in practically the whole province of Asia. He says that gods made by human hands are no gods at all. There is danger not only that our trade will lose its good name, but also that the temple of the great goddess Artemis will be discredited; and the goddess herself, who is worshiped throughout the province of Asia and the world, will be robbed of her divine majesty.”(Acts 19 26-27)

Demetrius masks his evil intent behind the need to support the spirituality and position of Diana. It was very effective in the short term, and incensed Ephesus against Christ and his servants.

This spirit of deception is very hard to break. It clothes itself in reason, in religion and in righteous indignation against any who would challenge it. Deception can be very hard for intercessors to oppose. Deception has undermined the commitment of many intercessors over the centuries. It is posing an ever increasing threat to intercession today.

* The despair of Jericho

“Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in.” (Joshua 6:1)

The town of Jericho was a prison, and everyone inside was shut in. It wasn't just the gates that shut them in. It was fear and despair. Despair robs people of all hope. They sink into a spiritual hopelessness, where there is no prospect of deliverance.

Intercessors should have nothing to do with despair but they have to function in a desperate world. Over many years of intercession it is possible for this despair to corrode the heart of the intercessor.

* The demonic destruction Molech

The Lord said to Moses, “Say to the Israelites: ‘Any Israelite or any foreigner residing in Israel who sacrifices any of his children to Molech is to be put to death’”.

(Leviticus.20:1-2)

“Then the king of Moab saw that the battle had gone against him, he took with him seven hundred swordsmen to break through to the king of Edom, but they failed. Then he took his firstborn son, who was to succeed him as king, and offered him as a sacrifice on the city wall.”

(2 Kings 3:26-27)

Molech represents great danger to the heritage of Korea and of any nation. This demonic destruction burns, butchers, corrupts and rapes - physically and spiritually. It will seek to destroy intercessors, either personally or within the culture in which they pray.

*** The pollution of Jezebel**

“Ahab not only considered it trivial to commit the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, but he also married Jezebel daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, and began to serve Baal and worship him.”

(1 Kings 16:31)

Jezebel polluted pure religion and there is a great deal of her spirit around today. Those who want to hold to the truth of faith and to the doctrines which have stood for 2000 years are finding themselves under intense pressure. Compromise is everywhere and it is polluting the purity of faith. Intercessors are living with this stream flowing around them all the time. It is hard to stand in this stream and remain pure. This is a tough struggle.

*** The bondage of the beast**

“The second beast was given power to give breath to the image of the first beast, so that the image could speak and cause all who refused to worship the image to be killed. It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads, so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name.”

(Revelation 13:15-17)

Diana, Molech, Jezebel - all come together in this demonic stronghold of the beast. Its aim is to be god. It will demand worship, kill all those who do not worship, enslave those who do surrender and rule nations with harshness. It is the beast which opposes this tower - wanting to break it, to destroy those who want to pray in it, and rule as God.

Once this stronghold gets established, there is very little hope, unless some are prepared to pay a very high price in sacrifice. It will be the intercessors who will be called on to pay the price.

Chapter 3. The battle which is raging

In the mid 19th century a prophecy, (which is not easy to ascribe) began to circulate. It spoke of a conversation between Satan and the Lord. The essence of the conversation was this –

Satan said “in 100 years I will have destroyed the church.” This may be an apocryphal story but it summarises the battle around the Korean tower. For some reason Satan has chosen this area of the world in which to try and destroy the church. Perhaps he wants to do it so that he can frighten others with his apparent achievement.

The church stands for freedom. ‘You shall know the truth and the truth will set you free.’ ‘If any man is in Christ he is a new creation.’ We are set free from our sins and are able to stand up and praise God. Satan however has the opposite intention –

The second beast was given power to give breath to the image of the first beast, so that the image could speak and cause all who refused to worship the image to be killed. It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads, so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name. (Revelation 13:15-17)

His fundamental aim used to get authority so that he can rule. How does he do this? He has many schemes but at its heart he must destroy the cross.

Here are some of the ways he does that -

*** In case the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.** (1 Corinthians 1:17)

The alternative to a powerful cross is a powerless one. Satan's cross is empty of all power - power to forgive, power to heal, power to release, power to triumph. He wants to achieve completely the opposite to the sacrifice of Jesus. He wants to bind, to chain, to pull down, to humiliate, to imprison.

*** Come down from the cross and save yourself!** (Mark 15:30)

Satan wants to make a mockery of the cross, Wanting to focus on the mockery of these words - **“Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!”** (Matt 27:40) He wants men and women to laugh at such a stupid idea. The mockery will blind eyes to the truth.

The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.(2 Corinthians 4:4)

*** Foolishness to those who are perishing**
(1 Corinthians.1:18)

Satan wants to reverse this verse - **“the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.”**
(1 Corinthians 1:18)

He wants It to read - “The message of the cross is foolishness to those who believe. It cannot save. It has no power.”

*** Reconcile both of them to God..**
(Ephesians 2:16)

Satan wants to break the cross, so that there is no reconciliation with God. The Bible says - **His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility.** (Ephesians 2:16) If Satan can break the cross, creation remains fallen, and in his power. Then he can mock its prisoners with the cross - “You really believed that this could save you? Well it cannot!”

*** “And having disarmed the powers and authorities.”** (Colossians 2:15)

Most of all, he wants to break this verse: - **“And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.”** He must eradicate this verse. He must destroy any idea that the cross has broken him, triumphed over him, made a public display of his powerlessness and failure.

He will try and turn eyes away from the triumph of Jesus. He will say "He is powerless. The cross marks his defeat. Look to me - I have the power."

This is his mission statement -

“Nations and peoples of every language, this is what you are commanded to do: As soon as you hear the sound of the horn, flute, zither, lyre, harp, pipe and all kinds of music, you must fall down and worship the image of gold that King Nebuchadnezzar has set up. Whoever does not fall down and worship will immediately be thrown into a blazing furnace.”

(Daniel 3:4-6)

Chapter 4. Resisting and releasing

Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today.

(Exodus 14:13)

The intercessors in this tower must resist. Here is my vision-

I went into the dark places. Spirits of destruction attacked me. “Kill him,” they cried. “Do to him what we did to the Liar.” I stood in silence and remembered the cross. A great scream broke out. From every side it beat against me. Louder and louder it got, rising up, louder and louder. It was a scream of fear and of despair. The violence of the demonic agony struck me. But I remembered the cross.

Whispers began. “He saved others but he could not save himself.” “He called but there was no answer.” “Who will see this sacrifice? Who cares?” “It is all a lie.” “See he is alone. No one answers him. What can he do against us?” But I filled my ears with the praise of heaven and continued to remember the cross.

Threats began. “We will destroy your children.” “We will defile your wife. You cannot defend them against us.” But I filled my mind with the promise of the Word, and continued to remember the cross.

Deceits came. “You are powerful. Go and show you power to the world. You need not fear us. We are reasonable. Don’t waste your power here.” But I remembered the Triumph. “We are more than conquerors.” I held on to the Triumph and continued to remember the cross.

Darkness engulfed me. I felt alone. Fear walked in the darkness like a lion looking for prey. But I remembered the Lord's glory. "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." I continued to manifest the cross. "Oh no," they cried. "Not that! Not that! Please not that!"

Then Satan and all his legions came before me and against me. Baal, Bel, Nimrod, Jezebel, the Curse, Jericho, Moab, Pharaoh, Diana, Legion, the Empire, Aggression, Lie and False god. They lifted their swords and came against me but I did not yield, because in this moment of showing his power, I saw his weakness and his defeat. I rejoiced in my wounds and in the blood and in the Spirit. Hell trembled. "Your days are numbered," I said, "and your defeat assured. You may rule for a time, but you will never reign and in this place I prove your defeat. Here I fall on my knees and worship Him who reigns over all - even this place."

Never!

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego set the standard for intercessors in this tower. When the king demanded obedience to the false gods they said this –

“King Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need to defend ourselves before you in this matter. If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty’s hand. But even if he does not, we want you to know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up.”
(Daniel 3:16-18)

Here is my vision and I hope it encourages intercessors in this tower to stand firm.

In the distance, I saw a strong man, armed and ready for battle. He rose in his strength and began to advance through the darkness towards me. He cut his way through all the defences, marching with anger and hate in his heart. His eyes were fixed on me. As he got closer, I read his name. It was “The thief comes to kill and steal and destroy.” On and on he came, until he stood before me, mighty, powerful, strong and hating. He lifted his sword to kill. But I was not afraid. The dark powers did not frighten me anymore, because the blood was in me, and hell must bow down. As I lived in this truth, the strong man grew smaller and smaller before me. His sword dropped away, and fear filled him.

Always!

Intercessors in this tower have the power to move the heart of God to release the spirit, to release the people, to release the nation and to release the wider region. The intercessors may seem small and insignificant and the problems and opposition vast.

Satan may have much to call on but we can release a greater power by our intercession and God will always do it, as the first Church discovered when Satan tried to destroy its leaders. The power to release lays with intercessors and so it will be for Korea.

So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him.

The night before Herod was to bring him to trial, Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains, and sentries stood guard at the entrance. Suddenly an angel of the Lord appeared and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him up. “Quick, get up!” he said, and the chains fell off Peter’s wrists. Then the angel said to him, “Put on your clothes and sandals.” And Peter did so. “Wrap your cloak around you and follow me,” the angel told him.

Peter followed him out of the prison, but he had no idea that what the angel was doing was really happening; he thought he was seeing a vision. They passed the first and second guards and came to the iron gate leading to the city. It opened for them by itself, and they went through it. When they had walked the length of one street, suddenly the angel left him.

Then Peter came to himself and said, “Now I know without a doubt that the Lord has sent his angel and rescued me from Herod’s clutches and from everything the Jewish people were hoping would happen.” (Acts 12:5-11)

Victory belongs to the intercessors!

Chapter 5. Rooms in the tower

As I have studied the towers and have tried to understand their character I have used the picture of rooms. These rooms equip the intercessors for their work from the top of the tower. Teresa of Avila also did this in her book “The interior castle.”

I have written about many towers and their rooms. The rooms found here are unusual. They focus on triumph, strength and being lifted up to resist. Perhaps the Korean intercessors have a special task and a special place in the world and need this extra encouragement to take on their task.

Door

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

These words from apostle Paul are written on the door. - Intercessors are not enduring against a hidden enemy. They know his strategies and deceits. He is a liar, (John 10:10) a false angel, (2 Corinthians 11:14) and a roaring lion (1 Peter 5:8). He shows himself as great and is prepared to fight hard and long (Revelation 13). Intercessors know that he is defeated, broken, diminishing and ultimately headed for the lake of fire.

“Be strong!” This verse sums up the whole of the function of this tower. The intercessors have to be strong in the Lord and in his power to resist the enemy. There has to be no gap in the armour.

Room of Praises

Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens. (Psalm 150:1)

Praise is the gift of the Lord which rises up to him and makes his people strong. This is how John saw it in Revelation-

Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders.

In a loud voice they were saying: “Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honour and glory and praise!” Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying:

“To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honour and glory and power, for ever and ever!” The four living creatures said, “Amen,” and the elders fell down and worshipped.

(Revelation 5:11)

Entering into this praise encourages and strengthens intercessors in this tower. It lifts the spirit.

Here is my experience.

I came to a place where angels were singing the praises of the Lord. I was not able to sing. I was sad and asked - "Why can I not sing this beautiful music?" "Look inside yourself," said the Lord. I looked into my heart and there I found many beautiful pearls. I reached out for them and praise filled me. Within my praise were beautiful white doves, soft, gentle, pure and perfect. They circled around me, and I began to sing a song of purity - a purity I had never felt before.

The praise most beautiful and I asked the Lord, "Where does this beautiful song come from?" "This song flows from the redeemed human spirit and has a beauty beyond price." The echo of this song will live in your soul until the end of time," said the Lord. I looked into his heart and was content.

Room of strength

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9)

"And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:20)

This theme has come back again and again in this tower. Resisting is going to be tough. The enemy must destroy this tower to gain access to many other countries. So this room equips the intercessors with the spiritual strength they need.

Here are the equipping weapons -

The blood

“And through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.”
(Ephesians 1:20)

A priest came to begin work in a town, and he was called out to see a sick member of his church. To his astonishment, when he met the person, a strange voice addressed him. It said “We are in charge of this town.” The priest had never experienced such a thing before, but he found the right response. “No you are not. We are going to preach about the blood of Jesus.” There was a pause, and then the strange voice replied, “We know. That is what we are afraid of.”

The cross

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (1 Corinthians 1:18)

Here is a visionary picture of the cross which I've always found quite helpful as I've been interceding.

The whirlwind was roaming across the continent of Africa. Everywhere it touched down it destroyed lives, communities and nations.

The enemy rejoiced in this destruction. “It is so easy,” he said. Then he turned his eyes to the next nation. “This one I will destroy,” he said, and sent the whirlwind of destruction towards it. “Nothing can stop me now,” he said, “I have been attacking this place for decades. Now my moment has come.”

But as he drew near, he saw something which he had not seen before. Everywhere there were small trees where there had been no trees before. He was puzzled, and looked closer. To his horror he saw that they were not trees but crosses, scattered everywhere and growing slowly into a forest, stretching as far as his eye could see across the whole land. “Oh no. Not that!” he groaned. “That I cannot overcome.” With bitter anger and spite he turned away. His attack was broken.

Resurrection

Jesus said to her, “Mary.” She turned toward him and cried out in Aramaic, “Rabboni.

(John 20:16)

Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die.”

(John 11:25)

The resurrection of Jesus is the ultimate weapon of the intercessors. They stand in its power. It is a cloak of protection around them and one way Satan can never break. It is written in history that he tried at the cross and failed. God's people are the victors.

Room of Triumph

“But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

(1 Corinthians 15:57)

Intercessors are the victors. The battle has been won. During the time between the Lord's ascension and his return this victory cannot be fully realised, yet it can be claimed. It becomes the framework of the intercessory heart. Intercessors are able to live in the end times return of Jesus and his victory even though it has not yet happened.

If intercessors can grasp this they have a power in them which can never be broken and the enemy will be forever backing away from them in defeat. The victory will shine out brightly. Apostle Paul sums this up really well -

“For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.”

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

(Romans 8:36-9)

Room of releasing

“You shall know the truth and the truth will set you free.” (John 10:10)

The intercessors in Korea have the potential to release great power into all the nations around about it. What does such release bring? The intercessors are people with emotional hearts so how might they feel about the release which they are interceding about?

I had this vision once about my own freedom and perhaps it might help intercessors begin to explore the path of releasing for themselves, their nation and others.

I saw a beautiful river, flowing from the throne of God. As it flowed, it whispered, “Come to me all who are weary, and I will give you rest.” I longed for rest, so I came close to the river. The closer I got the more beautiful it looked, the more it called and the more I wanted it.

Finally I came to the waters edge. But there I hesitated. I knew how dirty and sinful I was. How could I pollute this beauty? I saw the Lord in the river, calling, “Come.” I surrendered and fell into his arms, and then I discovered the truth. He was my river of delight. He was my comfort and my strength and my sure reward. In his arms I belonged, I rested and I grew strong.

Top of the tower

“If you love me, you will obey my commandments.
(John 14:15)

I have been seeking the Lord for the top of this tower and I expected to see great things but all I saw and heard was his command to love. I began to understand what he was saying. He is entrusting great power and responsibility to the Korean tower. So it is essential that the intercessors operate within a framework of love. Great spiritual power without love can puff up and destroy. With love it can achieve everything.
